Workshops

Workshop 1 (W1) Setting Up a Children's Church Workshop Building Blocks 1 – The House *by Andy Loh*

Interested in setting up a new Children's Ministry? Going for a Children's Church or converting a Sunday School or combining both? In this workshop we will share the mechanics of setting up a Children's Ministry. It will cover organisation framework, recruiting volunteers, and what it takes to start a whole new children's church from scratch.

Workshop 2 (W2) Clownology *by Sam Tee*

An exploration in clowning, development and its impact on your audience. See and learn how clowning around can warm up children's hearts to you and subsequently to the gospel. Learn how to develop a clown character that you like and how to put on clown makeup that is attractive and draws children and audience to you.

Workshop 3 (W3) Neato Blacklight Ideas *by John Coen*

Come and see lots of props and puppets that you can create to spice up your blacklight presentations. Be sure there will be lots of creative ideas to walk away that will excite your children's ministry. Questions and cameras welcome!

Workshop 4 (W4) Games that Teach *by Ruth Tan*

This workshop provides you with an understanding of the role of playing games in children's ministry and also attempts to give you a smorgasbord of games that teach Biblical truths

Workshop 5 (W5) Communicating to Pre-Teens *by Nicholas Choo*

This workshop focuses on reaching the Pre-Teens from 11 to 14 years old. They are highly active and want to be actively involved in the learning process. You will learn spiritual-social-emotional learning skills to lead pre-teens to commit to a responsible lifestyle.

Workshop 6 (W6) Praise & Worship Power Praise – Going Deeper *by Andy Loh*

All of us long to see our children worship the LORD with all of their hearts, mind, soul and strength. We as teachers need to understand a deeper meaning behind just lifting up of hands, doing the crazy actions and singing out loud. We ourselves need to know how to move sensitively in partnership with the Holy Spirit and to allow the LORD to speak to the kids. We will revisit the dynamics of what worship is and how to create a worship encounter for the kids so that they can capture the moment with the LORD.

Workshop 7 (W7) Clown Gestures and Movements *by Sam Tee*

Learn the gestures and movements of a clown to enhance your clowning acts and gospel shows.

Workshop 8 (W8) How to Make Puppets from Foam *by John Coen*

Learn how to make your own cool puppets using polyfoam. John will show you the techniques and tricks you will need. *(Participants would need to pay for materials used and puppets made are yours)*

Workshop 9 (W9) Creative Memorisation of Scriptures *by Ruth Tan*

This workshop provides you with exciting, creative and easy-to-use ideas to teach Scripture memory verses so as to make Scripture memory not only fun but also memorable and life changing.

Workshop 10 (W10) Cultivating Core Values in Children *by Nicholas Choo*

This workshop focuses on developing core values in children. Their attitude more than their aptitude will determine their future altitude. You will be introduced to a powerful eight-step framework to lead a child into responsible development of core values for life.

Workshop 11 (W11) Praise & Worship Power Praise – Hang Loose Time! *by Andy Loh*

"Arghhh...!!! The chaos! The noise! They are everywhere! And now they are out of control!" Sounds familiar? Let's tackle some of the mechanics during the Praise & Worship in children's church. Here we will talk about crowd control, keeping the kid's attention on the worship leader and at the same time pointing them towards God.

Workshop 12 (W12) Creative Arts in Missions *by Sam Tee*

Learn how to use creative arts in missions to reach out to children which is effective and not confined by language barriers.

Workshop 13 (W13) Puppet Fish Workshop *by John Coen*

Make a fish puppet that looks great in regular light or blacklight. Plus, take home the pattern to make a whole school. Class places limited, so please register early. *(Participants would need to pay for materials used and puppets made are yours)*

Workshop 14 (W14) Teaching to Change Lives *by Ruth Tan*

This workshop teaches you how to train and nurture our next generation to walk in God's way. The focus will be leading children to live a transforming lifestyle and raising them to make national impacts.

Workshop 15 (W15) Community Involvement with Kids *by Nicholas Choo*

This workshop guides children to love and care for the community. They are raised by God in this current generation to

touch lives permanently for Him. You will be introduced to a 3-month curriculum to prepare children to make a real difference to people around them.

Workshop 16 (W16) Setting Up a Children's Church Workshop Building Blocks 2 – The People *by Andy Loh*

People are your most treasured possession! What is needed to sow into the team's heart and life to encourage them to fly high and last long as you grow your Children's Ministry? This workshop will cover vision and passion casting and alignment to the vision God gave you and growing the team you have.

Workshop 17 (W17) Humour Therapy *by Sam Tee*

Humour therapy is a great skill you would want to acquire that be used for any mission relief work and surpasses language barriers.

Learn how to make a set of blacklight lips. Take the pattern home and make some more for your entire team. *(Participants would need to pay for materials used and puppets made are yours)*

Workshop 21 (W21) Praise & Worship Power Praise – The Team *by Andy Loh*

What songs to sing? How to choose them? How do we transit from song to song? Most of us in the worship team asked those questions before. Musicians play a big part in having a great time in worshipping the LORD. Worship leader's partnership with them is important to bring out the best in the time of worship. We will deal with team working with the musicians and the worship leaders.

Workshop 22 (W22) Fun with Balloons *by Sam Tee*

Have fun learning how to twist different balloon sculptures and shapes that will thrill your audience and have fun with them.

Workshop 23 (W23) Building a TEAM Ministry *by Nancy Lam*

You can build a dynamic team and move forward together where team efforts and synergy will energise and propel the ministry ahead. Learn the importance and dynamics of team ministry.

Workshop 24 (W24) Twelve tips for a successful Blacklight Performance *by John Coen*

Valuable advice from 16 years of blacklight performing that will make your puppet performances shine and children fascinated.

Workshop 25 (W25) Mentoring Your Kids (2) *by Nicholas Choo*

This workshop is a continuation of Mentoring Your Kids (1). You cannot attend this workshop without attending Mentoring Your Kids (1). It explains in detail the framework, the formation, the follow-through and the fruits of B.E.S.T. mentoring.
