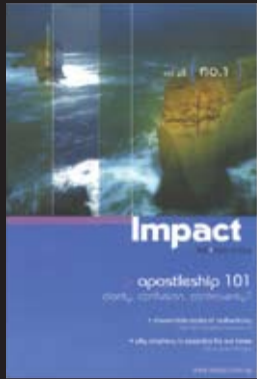


For every 10 men in the average U.S. church...

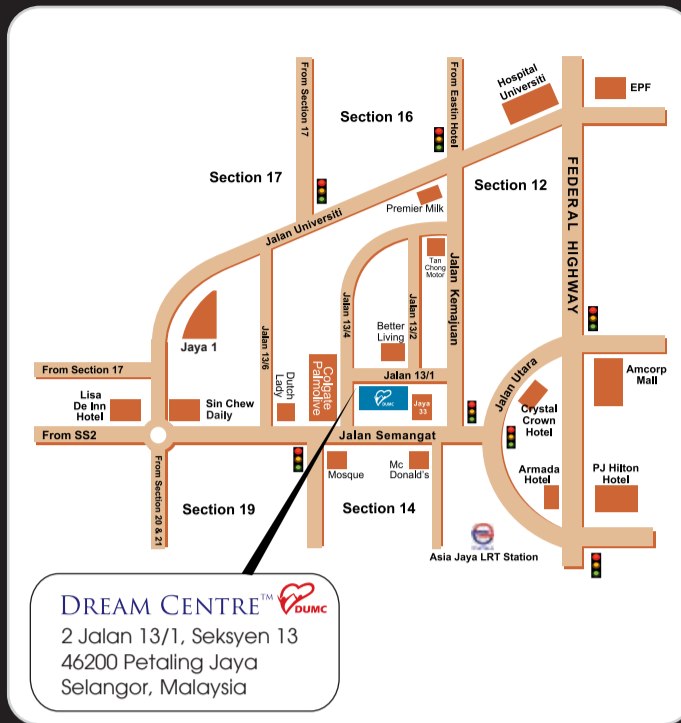
- 9 will have kids who leave the church

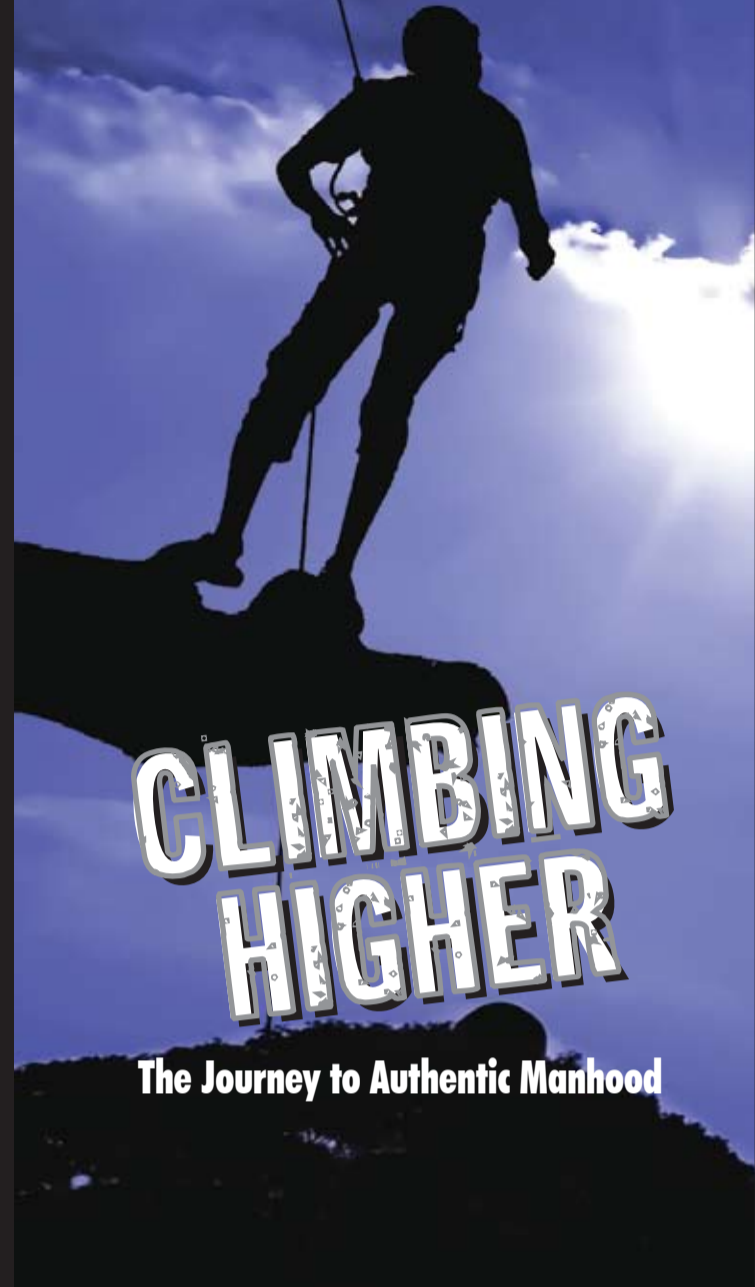

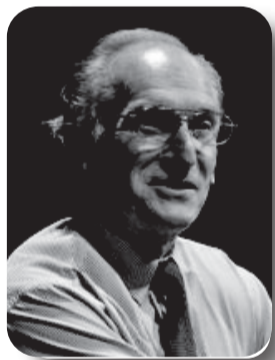

Dr. Geoff Gorsuch
Biography

Co-author of Men's Ministry, dealing with the issue of getting men into church, Geoff Gorsuch is also a co-founder of the National Coalition of Men's Ministries in the U.S., and a speaker for *Man in the Mirror* and *Promise Keepers*. Dr. Geoff holds a Master and Doctorate degree in Practical Ministry from Colorado Springs Leadership Institute. He's presently based in Singapore as the Executive Director of Life Coach, the Men's Ministry of the Navigators.

Impact: What's so different about ministering to men?

Gorsuch: I'll give you some basic differences that need to be respected. One difference is that men respond to challenge and women to security. Now challenge and security are on opposite poles to each other. You tell a man to climb a mountain, and he will say okay; let's figure out a way to do that. If you have too much routine and security and relationship, men are bored. They need to have adventure.

Another difference you have to respect is between the way men and women process frustration; men primarily through anger, and women primarily through tears. If the church does not create a place where men can express some anger ... that will cause them to stop coming.
